VISITATION POLICY FOR TRAPPING BROOK HOUSE

We acknowledge that the family system has been affected by substance use disorder and that the family system is important in recovery. We are also aware of the necessity to learn balance and be able to focus on self in recovery. The following is adopted as our Visitation and Family Policy.

A person or family member transporting the admitted resident may have a brief tour of the facility but is not to stay for a visit. As this time, they may be given the Visitation Policy and have any questions answered.

FIRST TEN (10) DAYS No visitation at our facility and no passes to meet visitors/family. Any alterations must be approved by the House Manager or Residential Director.

AFTER FIRST TEN (10) DAYS Visitation may occur on Sundays from 10am to 4:30pm, Saturdays from 10am to 4:30pm, provided they do not interfere with any scheduled house activities.

Any alterations in scheduling must be authorized by your case manager/house manager/Residential Director.

Visitors must sign in and out in the log on the sign-in counter near staff office. Visitors must sign the Visitors Confidentiality Statement Form. Visitors are to enter and exit from the door closest to the staff office. Visitors are not permitted upstairs.

Visitors must be drug and alcohol free at time of visit. Tobacco/Vape is not to be used on premises.

Visitors should at all times behave appropriately for a recovery environment. Visitors should be dressed conservatively (for instance, no halter tops or excessively short skirts, no clothing advertising drugs or alcohol, etc.). Visitor's wearing questionable attire or who are disruptive may be asked to leave.

Visitors may be asked to leave at any time at staff discretion.

Visits from former residents who have left our program unsuccessfully or those who have relapsed must be approved in advance by the Residence Director.

For the purposes of this policy, sponsors are considered visitors.

All packages and articles of clothing brought in by visitors are subject to search.

When a child is visiting, a parent or staff must be in visual or auditory distance of that child at all times.

At no time can a resident's child be left in the care of another resident or client.

Corporal punishment is prohibited by any person on the premises.
